

FREE AND CONFIDENTIAL **LEGAL HELP**

Many of life's problems are legal issues. We're here to help. The areas of law we help with include:

- Family law
- Family violence
- · Fines and debts
- . Being the victim of a crime
- Employment law (being underpaid, harassed at work, or unfairly fired)
- Minor criminal matters (property damage, theft, or possession of illicit substances)

There are many other ways we may be able to help. Give us a call and we will let you know if we can help, or refer you to a service that can.

WHAT TO EXPECT

Once you contact us, we will determine how we can best help. Our ability to help depends on our availability and the kind of help you need. We prioritise helping people who are facing financial hardship. Some ways we might help include:

- Free and confidential legal advice
- Support from social workers or financial counsellors
- Representation in court or help with mediation
- · Community legal education about the law, your rights and responsibilities

Beyond one-on-one legal help, we also empower our community through:

- · Advocating for better and fairer laws
- · Providing outreach and engagement through community programs
- Educating our community about the law, their rights and their responsibilities
- Training future lawyers and social workers to be leaders for social justice
