The Interfaith Network (IFN) of the City of Greater Dandenong is Australia's longest-serving interfaith network. IFN brings together people of diverse faiths and beliefs to foster understanding, respect, social cohesion and community harmony through dialogue, education, events and collaborative community engagement.

Position Purpose

Reporting to the Executive Officer, the Social Media Lead Volunteer will support IFN by strengthening its online presence, promoting events and initiatives, sharing stories of community impact, and helping connect people from diverse faith and cultural backgrounds through engaging and professional digital communications.

Key Responsibilities

- Develop, schedule and publish content across LinkedIn, Facebook and Instagram.
- Promote IFN events, Places of Worship Tours, educational programs and community initiatives.
- Promote fundraising initiatives.
- Create engaging written, photographic and graphic content aligned with IFN branding.
- Draft community stories, event summaries and promotional materials.
- Monitor social media engagement and escalate enquiries where required.
- Maintain and update website content, events, resources and news items.
- Review website functionality and ensure information remains current and accurate.
- Assist with e-newsletters and digital communications.
- Track social media performance and provide basic analytics reports.

- Understanding of and respect for cultural and faith diversity
- Commitment to the IFN Vision of 'Many Faiths, One People'
- Commitment to the IFN Values of Respect, Harmony, Diversity, Integrity and Education

- Strong written and verbal communication skills
- Experience using Facebook, Instagram and LinkedIn
- Basic website content management experience
- Ability to work independently and manage priorities
- Current National Police Check and Working with Child Children or willingness to apply, complete these checks
- A time commitment of 4 hours per week

Desirable

- Experience with Canva, WordPress, photography, videography or digital marketing.
